BY-LAW No. 1279-2013

To assume municipal services located in and on the streets on Plan 66M-2465.

Whereas the City has entered into a Subdivision Agreement with Red Barn Investments Inc. to provide for the public highways and municipal services on Plan 66M-2465 and all affected City Divisions have no objection to the City's intention to assume the municipal services installed pursuant to the Subdivision Agreement;
