BY-LAW No. 1425-2013

To confirm the proceedings of Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting held on October 17, 2013 as it relates to decisions made under delegated authority.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The action of the Toronto and East York Community Council on October 17, 2013, taken under the delegated authority of Sections 27-149B and 27-152 of Chapter 27, Council Procedures, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, in respect of Items 27.12, 27.13, 27.14, 27.15, 27.16, 27.17, 27.18, 27.19, 27.20, 27.21, 27.22, 27.23, 27.24, 27.35, 27.39, 27.40, 27.41, 27.42, 27.44, 27.45, 27.46, 27.48, 27.50, 27.51, 27.52, 27.54, 27.57, 27.58, 27.59, 27.60, 27.63 and 27.69 of the Toronto and East York Community Council, up to and including the enactment of this Confirmatory By-law at the conclusion of its meeting at 2:56 p.m. this day, and in respect of each motion, resolution and other action, passed and taken under delegated authority including the enactment of any previous Confirmatory By-laws in respect of the meeting, is adopted, ratified and confirmed.
2. The Mayor and the proper officers of the City are authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the action or to obtain approvals where required, and except where otherwise provided, the City Clerk and the Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix the City's seal to the documents.
3. This By-law, to the extent to which it provides authority for or constitutes the exercise by the Community Council of its powers to proceed with, or to provide any money for, any undertaking, work, project, scheme, act, matter or thing which requires an approval in addition to the approval of the Community Council, shall not take effect until the additional approval has been obtained.
