## **BY-LAW No. 1431-2013**

## To effect interim control for lands generally bounded by Warden Avenue and Birchmount Road, immediately north and south of Ellesmere Road, as detailed in Schedule '1' to this By-law.

Whereas Council of the City of Toronto has, by adopting MM41.37 at its meeting of November 13, 14, 15 and 18, 2013, directed that a study be undertaken reviewing land use permissions of the employment lands north and south of Ellesmere Road, between Warden Avenue and Birchmount Road; and

Whereas authority is given to Council by Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass an Interim Control By-law for a period of time not exceeding one year from the date of passage of the By-law for such purposes as set out in the By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- On the lands shown within the heavy lines on the attached Schedule '1' to this By-law, Recycling, as defined at Clause IV to Scarborough Employment District Zoning By-law No. 24982, and Recovery Facilities, as defined at Chapter 800 of City of Toronto Zoning By-law No. 569-2013, shall be prohibited uses.
- 2. This By-law shall expire one year from the date of enactment by City Council.
