BY-LAW No. 1433-2013

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures,
to suspend certain powers of the Mayor for the remainder of the Council term.**

Whereas pursuant to Municipal Code Chapter 27-7, Council Procedures, Council may suspend rules in the Procedures By-law and substitute special rules for a defined period of time;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, § 27-40 and the related rule in § 27-126F are suspended for the balance of the current term of City Council and the following special rules are substituted:
 - (a) If vacancy occurs in the office of Deputy Mayor, Council shall appoint a Deputy Mayor.
 - (b) If a vacancy occurs in the position of Standing Committee Chair, the Standing Committee Chair shall be elected by the respective committee.
 - (c) If a Standing Committee Chair resigns as Chair and as a member of the Executive Committee, despite the resignation, he or she shall remain as a member-at-large of the committee of which he or she was Chair.
