BY-LAW No. 1436-2013

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 59, Emergency Management.

Whereas Chapter 59, Emergency Management, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code (the "Chapter") confers certain authority on the Mayor of the City of Toronto; and

Whereas, to the extent it has authority to do so, City Council wishes to remove such authority from the Mayor and confer it on the Deputy Mayor;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The Chapter is amended by deleting all references to "the Mayor" in §§ 59-6C, 59-7C and D, 59-10C, 59-12D and 59-14 and substituting "the Deputy Mayor".
2. The Chapter is further amended by deleting § 59-2A.
3. Pursuant to its authority under § 59-6D of the Chapter, the Toronto Emergency Management Program Committee will make changes to the Program, as required, to reflect the amendments to the Chapter enacted by this by-law.
4. This by-law remains in effect until November 30, 2014.
