1. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

(From Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(From Column 2 Direction)	(From Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(From Column 4 Times or Days)
Lake Shore Boulevard East and Carlaw Avenue	Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times or Days)
Lake Shore Boulevard East and Carlaw Avenue	Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red, except during southbound right-turn green-arrow signal phase
