BY-LAW No. 1553-2013

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Prince Edward Drive North and Prince Edward Drive South.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXV (Speed Limits on Public Highways) in § 950-1334, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Turns Prohibited)
Prince Edward Drive	Berry Road and Dundas Street West	40

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXV (Speed Limits on Public Highways) in § 950-1334, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)
Prince Edward Drive North	Bloor Street West and Queen Anne Road	40
Prince Edward Drive North	Queen Anne Road and Government Road	30
Prince Edward Drive North	Government Road and Dundas Street West	40
Prince Edward Drive South	Berry Road and Bloor Street West	40

C. By inserting in Schedule XL (Highways With Traffic Calming Measures) in § 950-1339, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)
Prince Edward Drive North	Queen Anne Road and Government Road

2. Section 1 of this By-law comes into effect on the day following the date the City Clerk certifies the results of the poll of eligible residents related to the alteration of Prince Edward Drive as favourable, in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 190, Polling and Notification, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code.
