BY-LAW No. 1557-2013

To authorize the alteration of Prince Edward Drive between Government Road and Queen Anne Road by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Prince Edward Drive, between Government Road and Queen Anne Road, was conducted, and as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Etobicoke York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Prince Edward Drive;

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

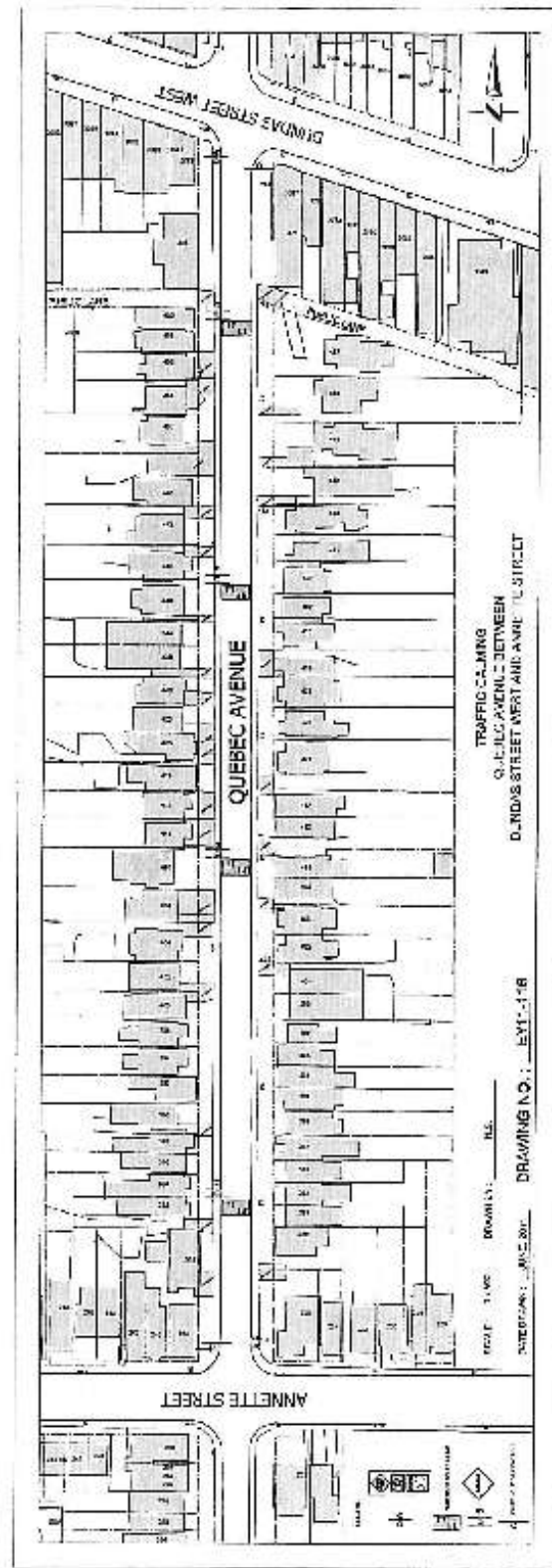
1. The alteration of Prince Edward Drive, between Government Road and Queen Anne Road by the installation of four speed humps as shown on Drawing No. EY13-217 dated September, 2013 attached to this By-law is hereby authorized.
2. Section 1 of this By-law comes into effect on the day following the date the City Clerk certifies the results of the poll of eligible residents related to the alteration of Prince Edward Drive as favourable, in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 190, Polling and Notification, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code.
