BY-LAW No. 59-2014

To authorize the alteration of Barrington Avenue between Balfour Avenue and Doncaster Avenue by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Barrington Avenue, between Balfour Avenue and Doncaster Avenue was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Barrington Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

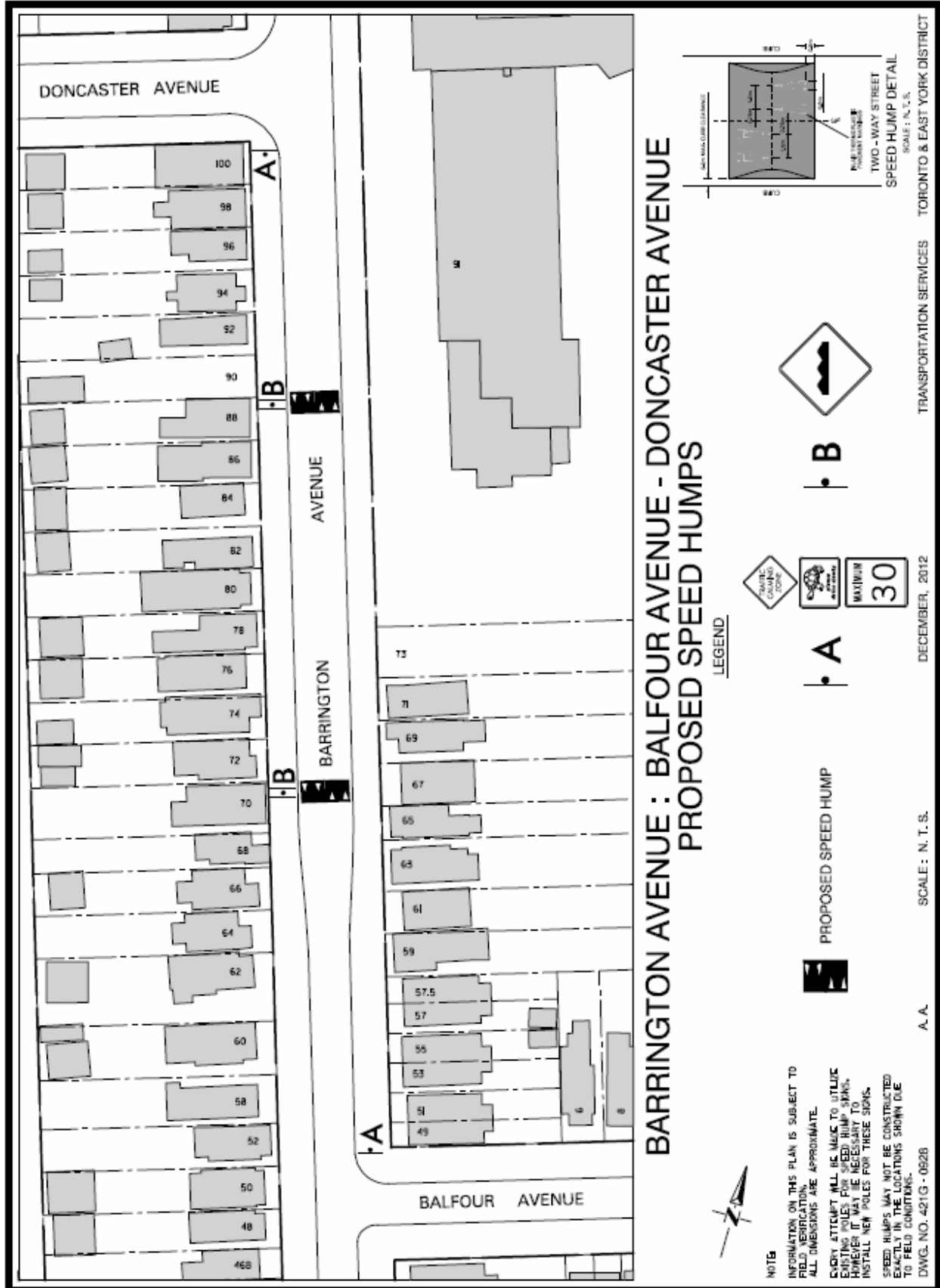
