BY-LAW No. 200-2014

To authorize the naming of a public lane located west of Euclid Avenue between Follis Avenue and Barton Avenue as "Mission House Lane".

Whereas pursuant to § 27-152E(5) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, Toronto and East York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law naming the public lane;

Lane Plan 219 Toronto abutting Lots 206 to 215;

City of Toronto and Province of Ontario,
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

and shown as PART 7 on the sketch attached to this By-law is named "Mission House Lane".

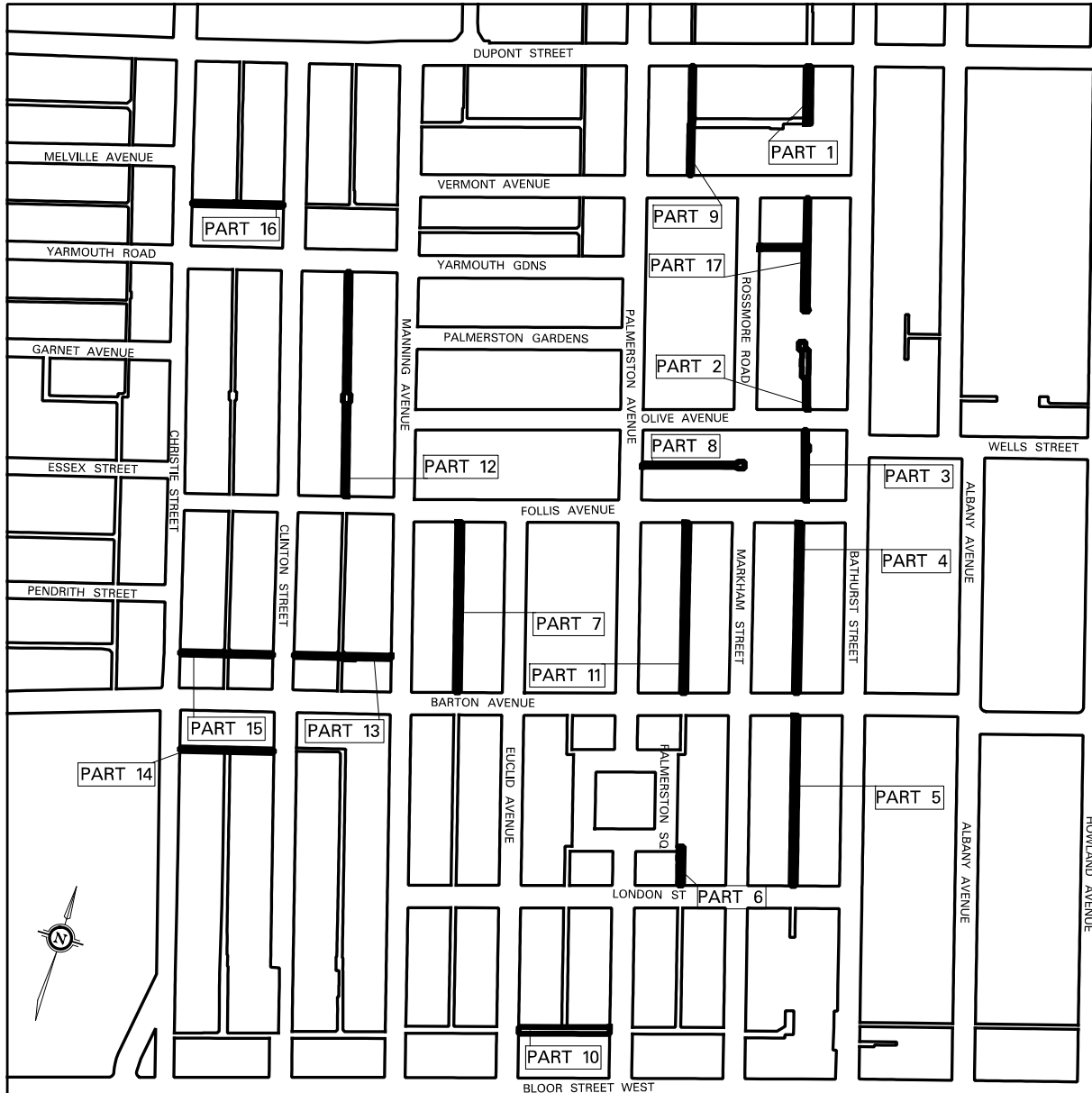
