BY-LAW No. 229-2014

To permanently close portions of the public lane extending easterly from Ledbury Street between Cranbrooke Avenue and Woburn Avenue.

Whereas it is recommended that a portion of the public highway consisting of portions of the public lane extending easterly from Ledbury Street between Cranbrooke Avenue and Woburn Avenue be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of the highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and North York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on February 25, 2014;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The public highway consisting of a portion of the public lane extending easterly from Ledbury Street between Cranbrooke Avenue and Woburn Avenue described as follows is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 10190-0494 (LT)

Part of a One Foot Reserve and Part of a Lane, Plan M108, designated as Parts 10 to 14 inclusive and Parts 32 to 39 inclusive on Reference Plan 66R-26720, City of Toronto.
