Lane".

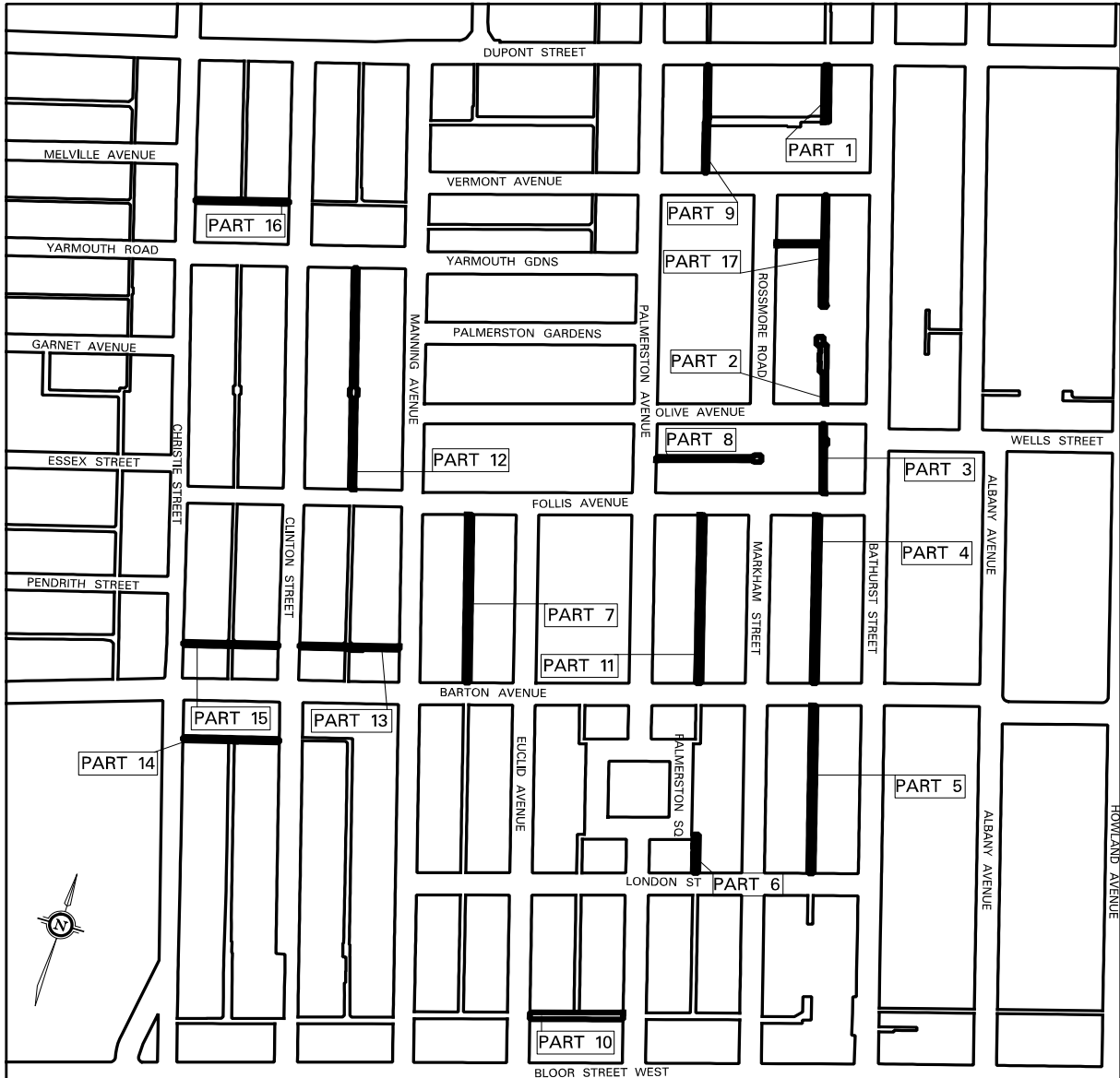
