To repeal By-law No. 490-2012 designating the property at 17 Dundonald Street (Commercial Travellers' Association of Canada Building) as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

Whereas City Council passed By-law No. 490-2012, being a by-law to designate the property at 17 Dundonald Street (Commercial Travellers' Association of Canada Building) as being of cultural heritage value or interest; and

Whereas the owner of the property applied to City Council for consent to demolish the heritage property at 17 Dundonald Street; and

Whereas City Council consented to the application to demolish; and

Whereas in accordance with the *Ontario Heritage Act*, where Council consents to an application to demolish, Council shall pass a by-law to repeal the designating by-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. By-law No. 490-2012 being a by-law to designate the property at 17 Dundonald Street as being of cultural heritage value or interest is repealed.
- 2. The City Solicitor is authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" to this by-law in the proper Land Registry Office.
- 3. The City Clerk shall delete reference to the property at 17 Dundonald Street from the heritage property register.
- 4. The City Clerk is authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owners of the property at 17 Dundonald Street and upon the Ontario Heritage Trust and to cause notice of this by-law to be posted on the City's web site for a period of 30 days in accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 162, Notice, Public, Article II, § 162-4. Notice requirements under the *Ontario Heritage Act*.
