**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 727-2014**

**To repeal interim control By-law No. 1393-2012 effecting lands on Queen Street West between Roncesvalles Avenue and Dufferin Street on the south side and between Roncesvalles Avenue and Noble Street on the north side.**

Whereas City of Toronto Council at its meeting on October 30, 31 and November 1, 2012 enacted Interim Control By-law No. 1393-2012 prohibiting new restaurants and restricting existing restaurants to the ground floor on Queen Street West between Roncesvalles Avenue and Dufferin Street; and

Whereas the expiry date of By-law No. 1393-2012 was extended by Section 38(6.1) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as a result of the appeals of By-law Nos. 1049-2013 and 1050-2013;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law No. 1393-2012 being a by-law, "To effect interim control on those lands on Queen Street West between Roncesvalles Avenue and Dufferin Street on the south side and Roncesvalles Avenue and Noble Street on the north side", is hereby repealed.
