**BY-LAW No. 740-2014**

**To authorize the naming of a proposed public street extending westerly from Brandon Avenue between Lansdowne Avenue and Foundry Avenue as "Brandon Avenue".**

and shown on the sketch attached to this By-law is named "Brandon Avenue".

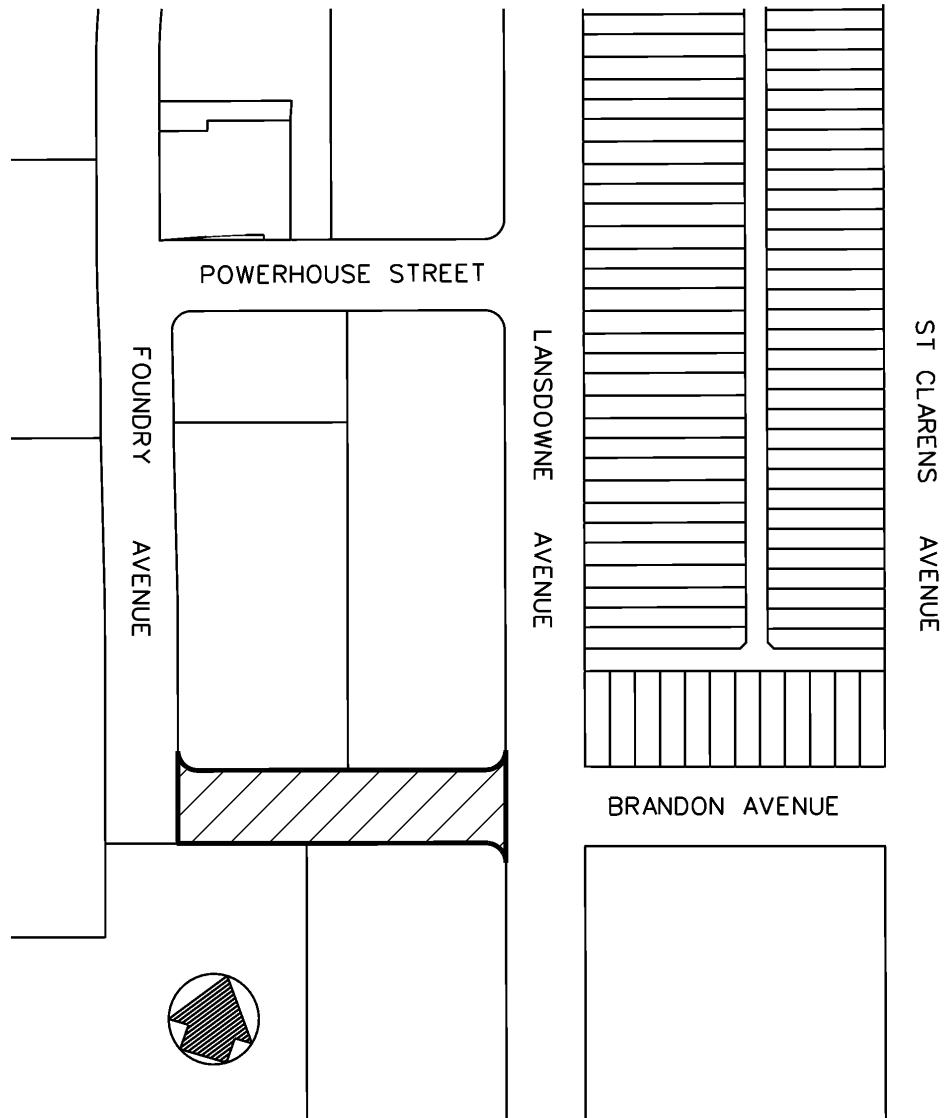

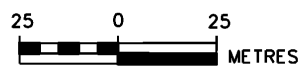
