BY-LAW No. 965-2014

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways,
Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Yonge Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Yonge Street	Queens Quay East and a point 110 metres north	Northbound lane adjacent to curb lane used for parking	Anytime
Yonge Street	A point 110 metres north of Queens Quay East and The Esplanade	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Yonge Street	Queens Quay West and Front Street West	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
