- A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Shaughnessy Boulevard	A point approximately 45 metres north of Sheppard Avenue East and Glentworth Road	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Shaughnessy Boulevard	Sheppard Avenue East and Delverton Place	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
