To permanently close portions of a public lane located at the rear of 5571 and 5575 Yonge Street to vehicular traffic.

Whereas it is recommended that the portions of the public lane located at the rear of 5571 and 5575 Yonge Street, designated as Part 8 on Reference Plan 64R-14258 and Part 1 on Reference Plan 66R-27540, City of Toronto be permanently closed to vehicular traffic; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close portions of the said lane to vehicular traffic was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and North York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on August 12, 2014;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Portions of the public lane located at the rear of 5571 and 5575 Yonge Street described as follows, is hereby permanently closed to vehicular traffic:
