BY-LAW No. 89-2015

To technically amend By-law No. 1021-2014 with respect to the lands municipally known as 67 Kirkdene Drive in order to reflect the correct performance standard numbers intended to be applied to the site.

Whereas authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

Whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*; and

Whereas City Planning has determined that a technical amendment must be made to By-law No. 1021-2014 to reflect the correct number the performance standards intended to apply to the site;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Section 1 of By-law No. 1021-2014, is amended by adding performance standard 163 to the zoning on the lands so that it reads as follows:
 - 1. **SCHEDULE "A"** is amended by deleting the current zoning for the lands outlined in Schedule '1' and replacing it with the following so that the amended zoning shall read as follows:

T - 39C - 58B - 149 - 163 - 164 -165 - 235 - 356 T - 40P - 43 - 149 - 163 - 164 - 165 - 236 T - 39C - 44A - 149 - 163 - 164 - 165 - 237

- 2. Schedule '1' of By-law No. 1021-2014 is deleted and replaced with the Schedule '1' attached to this by-law.
- **3**. Section 3 of By-law No. 1021-2014 is deleted in its entirety.
- 4. Schedule '2' of By-law No. 1021-2014 is deleted in its entirety.
