**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 215-2015**

**To make technical amendments to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162, Notice, Public, to update statutory references.**

Whereas Section 162-1 of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 defines NEWSPAPER as "The same meaning as in subsection 29(1) of the *Interpretation Act*"; and

Whereas the *Interpretation Act*, R.S.O 1990, c. I.11 was repealed on July 25, 2007 and replaced with the *Legislation Act, 2006*; and

Whereas Section 87 the *Legislation Act, 2006* defines the word "newspaper"; and

Whereas under Section 169-26B of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code to update the by-law to refer to the current statute;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 162, Notice, Public, is amended by deleting the definition of NEWSPAPER in Section 162-1 and replacing it with the following:

NEWSPAPER - The same meaning as in Section 87 of the *Legislation Act, 2006*.
