BY-LAW No. 436-2015

To authorize the alteration of Ivy Avenue between Prust Avenue and Greenwood Avenue by the installation of speed humps and to repeal By-law Nos. 470-2014 and 815-2014.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Ivy Avenue between Leslie Street and Greenwood Avenue was conducted and although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Ivy Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

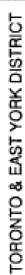
