BY-LAW No. 465-2015

To appoint Giuliana Carbone as a Deputy City Manager.

Whereas under section 140 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, the City may appoint a chief administrative officer; and

Whereas under section 77 of the *Legislation Act*, the power to appoint a person to a public office includes the power to appoint a deputy; and

Whereas under section 67 of the Legislation Act, words in the singular include the plural; and

Whereas Council has approved an administrative structure in which the City's chief administrative officer is called the "City Manager" and is to be assisted by two Deputy City Managers and a Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Giuliana Carbone is appointed to the office of Deputy City Manager (Social and Community Services) effective June 1, 2015, provided that Ms. Carbone and the City of Toronto finalize a written contract of employment prior to that date.
- 2. Ms. Carbone shall have those duties and responsibilities of the City Manager under Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, as may be assigned by the City Manager from time to time.
- **3.** City of Toronto By-law No. 891-2011, "To appoint Brenda Patterson as Deputy City Manager", is repealed.
