

Authority: Scarborough Community Council Item SC7.2, as adopted by City of Toronto Council on July 7, 8 and 9, 2015

BY-LAW No. 767-2015

To permanently close a portion of the public highway known as Meadowglen Place (the "Highway").

Whereas authority is given to Council, it is recommended that a portion of the public highway known as Meadowglen Place, City of Toronto (the "Highway") be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close a portion of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162, Notice, Public and the Scarborough Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on June 16, 2015;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The portion of the public highway known as Meadowglen Place, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as public highway:

Part of Meadowglen Place on Plan M-856, designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 66R-27936, City of Toronto, (former City of Scarborough) Province of Ontario.
