BY-LAW No. 812-2015

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, to authorize the General Manager, Transportation Services, to approve road closures up to and including 90 days for the Metrolinx Eglinton Crosstown Project.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, is amended as follows:
 - A. By inserting a new section 937-2.1 as follows:

"§ 937-2.1 Metrolinx Eglinton Crosstown Project.

Despite any other by-law, during the period between the completion of the scheduled July 7, 8 and 9, 2015 City Council Meeting and the agenda closing date in August or September, 2015 for the appropriate Community Council or Standing Committee, the General Manager, Transportation Services, may temporarily close to vehicular and pedestrian traffic any highway or portion of a highway for a period up to and including 90 days as required for the purposes of the construction of the Metrolinx Eglinton Crosstown Project."

B. By amending Section 937-4 to insert after the phrase: "set out in § 937-2" the phrase: ", 937-2.1".
