CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 856-2015

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Ardagh Street, Criscoe Street, Earlsdale Avenue, Evans Avenue, Quebec Avenue, St. Johns Road and Windermere Avenue.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Ardagh Street	North	A point 21 metres west of Willard Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Criscoe Street	East	A point 85 metres north of Henrietta Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Earlsdale Avenue	South	A point 45 metres west of Winona Drive and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
St. Johns Road	South	A point 10 metres west of Fiskin Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Evans Avenue	West	A point 24 metres north of Colbeck Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Quebec Avenue	East	A point 150 metres north of Annette Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Windermere Avenue	East	A point 16 metres south of Briarcroft Road and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
