## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## BY-LAW No. 1131-2015

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, to delete obsolete classes and definitions and to include various amendments.

Whereas under sections 7 and 8 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* (the "Act"), the City may pass by-laws in respect of the health, safety and well-being of persons and the economic, social and environmental well-being of the City; and

Whereas the Act grants the City of Toronto the authority to enact by-laws for the licensing, regulating and governing of businesses wholly or partly carried on in the City of Toronto, including the ability to require the payment of fees; and

Whereas Section 169-26B of City of Toronto Municipal Code authorizes the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, to submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, § 545-1 is amended by deleting the following definition:
  - "ACUPUNCTURE and/or TRADITIONAL MEDICINE ORGANIZATION"
- 2. Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is amended by deleting § 545-271.
- **3.** Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is amended by deleting Appendix F, Application for License for Special Sale.
