BY-LAW No. 622-2016

To authorize the naming of a public lane located south of Bloor Street West extending westerly from Clinton Street, as "Laundry Lane".

and shown as PART 1 on the sketch attached to this By-law is named "Laundry Lane".

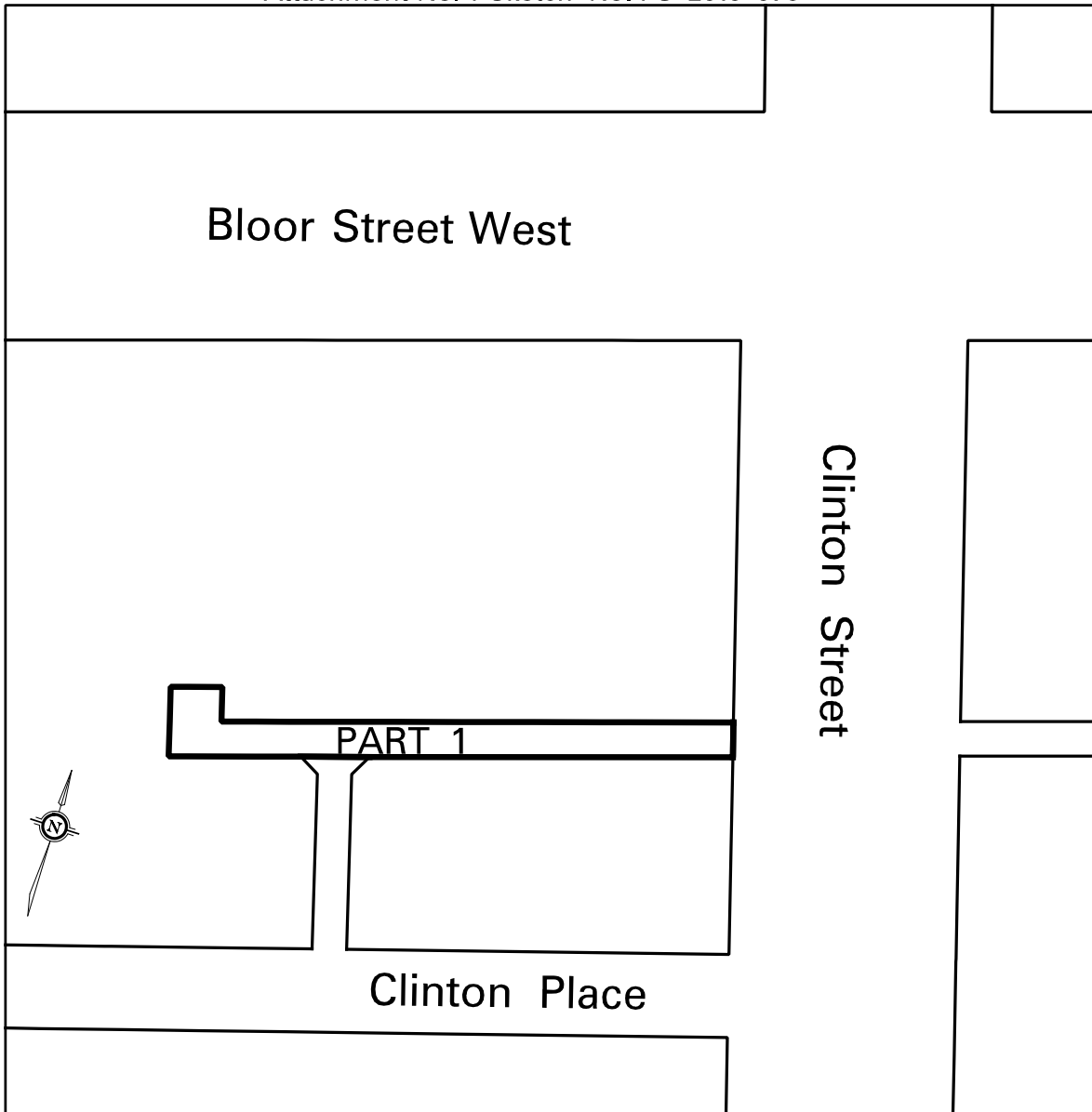
