BY-LAW No. 626-2016

To authorize the alteration of Raglan Avenue between St. Clair Avenue West and Claxton Boulevard by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Raglan Avenue between St. Clair Avenue West and Claxton Boulevard was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Raglan Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Raglan Avenue between St. Clair Avenue West and Claxton Boulevard by the installation of six speed humps as shown on Drawing No. 421G-1892 dated September, 2015 attached to this By-law is authorized.
