**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 723-2016**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, to reflect the expanded boundaries of the College Promenade Business Improvement Area.**

Whereas City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas designates various areas of the City as Business Improvement Areas, including the College Promenade Business Improvement Area; and

Whereas by the enactment of By-law No. 722-2016 on July 15, 2016, City Council designated an area that includes the existing College Promenade Business Improvement Area (as described in By-law No. 515-2005) as an improvement area; and

Whereas Schedule A of Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, must be amended to reflect the designation of the expanded College Promenade Business Improvement Area;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, is amended as follows:
  - A. The table in Schedule A of Municipal Code Chapter, 19 Business Improvement Areas, is amended by deleting By-law No. "515-2005" beside the name "College Promenade " in the "Designating By-law (Former Municipality)" column and substituting "515-2005 as amended by 722-2016"; and
  - B. Schedule A, Maps is amended by deleting the map of the College Promenade Business Improvement Area and substituting the map of the College Promenade Business Improvement Area attached to this by-law.

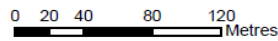
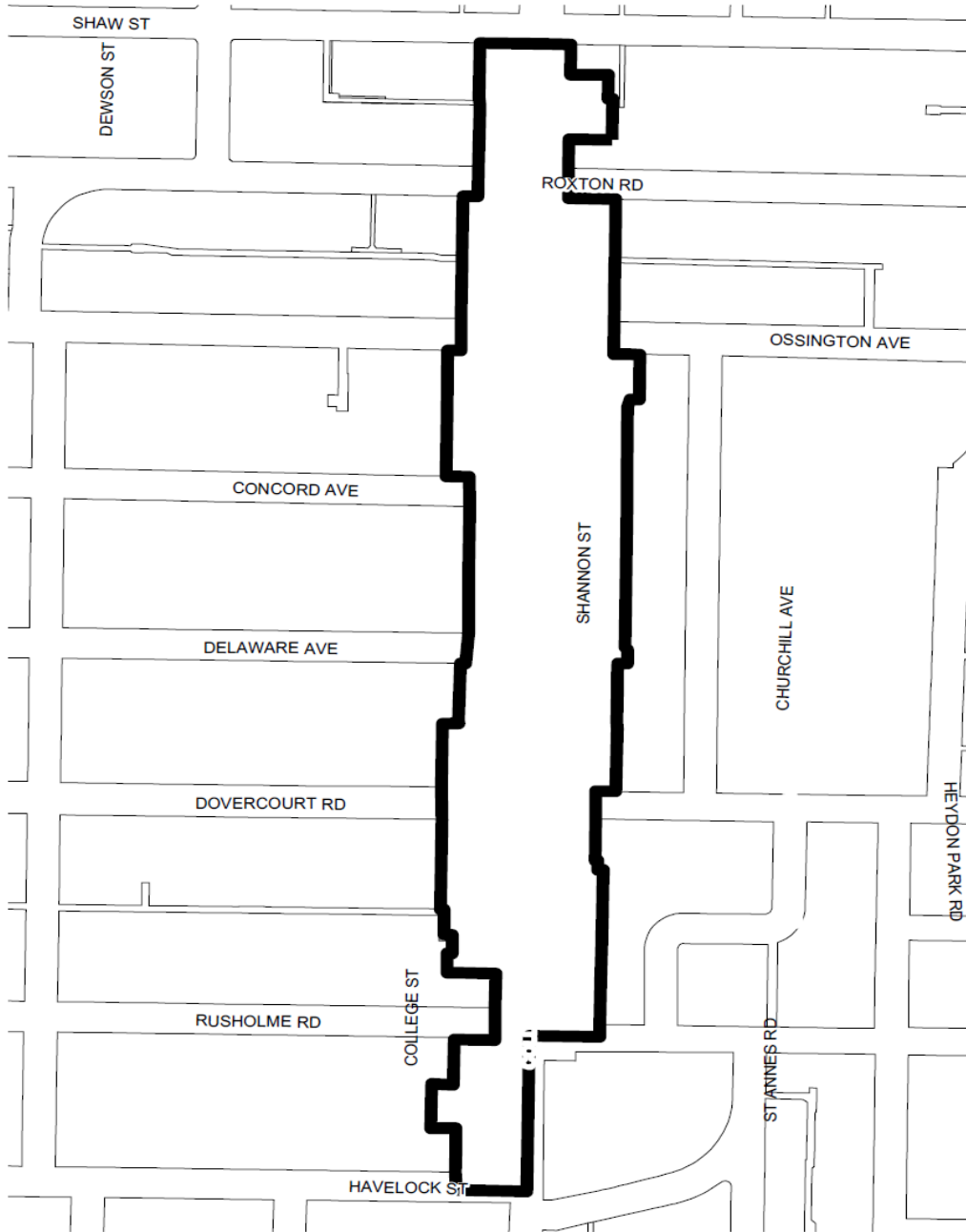
