BY-LAW No. 943-2016

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880, Fire Routes, respecting Birchmount Road and Commander Boulevard.

Whereas City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880 provides for the inclusion of locations in the City of Toronto as designated fire routes where such locations meet the requirements of that Chapter; and

Whereas the Fire Chief is satisfied that the locations described below meets the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880 for inclusion of these locations as designated fire routes;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. That part or those parts of the private road or roads shown on the site plan filed with the Fire Chief in respect of the municipal addresses set out below in this By-law is designated as fire routes pursuant to Municipal Code Chapter 880, Fire Routes, and Schedule A to Municipal Code Chapter 880 shall be amended by adding the following addresses:
 - (a) 1510 Birchmount Road
 - (b) 115 Commander Boulevard
 - (c) 161 Commander Boulevard

thereby including these locations as designated fire routes within the meaning of the By-law.
