CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 964-2016

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 743, Streets and Sidewalks, Use of, to clarify requirements for hockey and basketball net encroachments.

Whereas pursuant to Section 169-26 of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors, to update the by-laws to refer to the current statute, City official title, administrative unit and Municipal Code provision and to repeal by-laws of the former municipalities that have been superseded by provisions in the Municipal Code or as a result of an administrative reorganization;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 743, Streets and Sidewalks, Use of, is amended by deleting the phrase "provided that they are maintained in accordance with Article V at the expense of the owner or occupier of land to which the encroachments are appurtenant and is subject to compliance with the conditions as set out in Subsection H." in § 743-31I and replacing it with the following:

"provided that the net encroachments are maintained in accordance with Article V at the expense of the owner or occupier of land to which the encroachments are appurtenant and are subject to compliance with the conditions as set out in Subsection H."

Enacted and passed on October 7, 2016.
