BY-LAW No. 994-2016

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Isaac Devins Boulevard.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Isaac Devins Boulevard	North and East	A point 64 metres east of Abraham Welsh Road and a point 21 metres further southeast	Anytime

B. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Isaac Devins Boulevard	North and East	Mary Chapman Boulevard and a point 9 metres north of McCartney Street	8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.	12 hours

C. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Isaac Devins Boulevard	North and East	Mary Chapman Boulevard (north intersection) and a point 64 metres east of Abraham Welsh Road	8:00 p.m. of one day to 8:00 a.m. of the next following day	12 hours
