BY-LAW 791-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Bellevue Avenue, Davenport Road, Denison Avenue, Renforth Drive, Waterloo Avenue and Wolseley Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Times or Days)
Waterloo Avenue	Dufferin Street and Gladstone Avenue	Northerly westbound	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Bellevue Avenue	Wales Avenue and a point 35.7 metres south of College Street	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Davenport Road	Madison Avenue and Spadina Road	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
Denison Avenue	Dundas Street West and Wales Avenue	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Denison Avenue	Carr Street and Grange Avenue	Easterly Northbound lane adjacent to curb lane used for parking	Anytime
Denison Avenue	Queen Street West and Carr Street	Easterly Northbound	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Renforth Drive	Rathburn Road and Eglinton Avenue West	Easterly Northbound and Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Renforth Drive	West Wareside Road and Rathburn Road	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Waterloo Avenue (TO)	Dufferin Street and Gladstone Avenue	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
Wolseley Street	Augusta Avenue and Denison Avenue	Northerly Westbound	Anytime
