BY-LAW 66-2018

To authorize the alteration of Robbins Avenue, between Coxwell Avenue and the east end of Robbins Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Robbins Avenue, between Coxwell Avenue and the east end of Robbins Avenue, was conducted, and as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Robbins Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Robbins Avenue, between Coxwell Avenue and the east end of Robbins Avenue by the installation of four speed humps as shown on Drawing 421G-2676, dated September 2017 attached to this By-law is authorized.

Enacted and passed on January 16, 2018.
