BY-LAW 344-2018

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Railway Lane and Victoria Boulevard.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Victoria Boulevard	North	Weston Road and the east end of Victoria Boulevard	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Railway Lane	East	Ray Avenue and Victoria Boulevard	Anytime
Victoria Boulevard	North	Weston Road and Railway Lane	Anytime

C. By deleting from Schedule XVIII (One-Way Highways) in § 950-1317, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Times and/or Days)	(From Column 4 Direction)
Lane first east of Jane Street	Nickle Street and Ray Avenue	Anytime	Eastsouthbound

D. By inserting in Schedule XVIII (One-Way Highways) in § 950-1317, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Times and/or Days)	(In Column 4 Direction)
Railway Lane	Nickle Street and Ray Avenue	Anytime	Southbound

E. By deleting from Schedule XLI (Speed Control Zones - Public Laneways) in § 950-1340, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From
Column 1
Highways or Lanes)

First lane east of Weston Road, between Victoria Boulevard and Nickle Street as shown on Sketch No. 1.

F. By inserting in Schedule XLI (Speed Control Zones - Public Laneways) in § 950-1340, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Column 1
Highways or Lanes)

Railway Lane, between Victoria Boulevard and Nickle Street, as shown on Sketch No. 1.
