BY-LAW 387-2018

To authorize the naming of a public lane located north of Bloor Street West, extending between Palmerston Avenue and Markham Street as Eleanor Ross Lane.

and shown as PART 4 on the sketch attached to this By-law is named Eleanor Ross Lane.

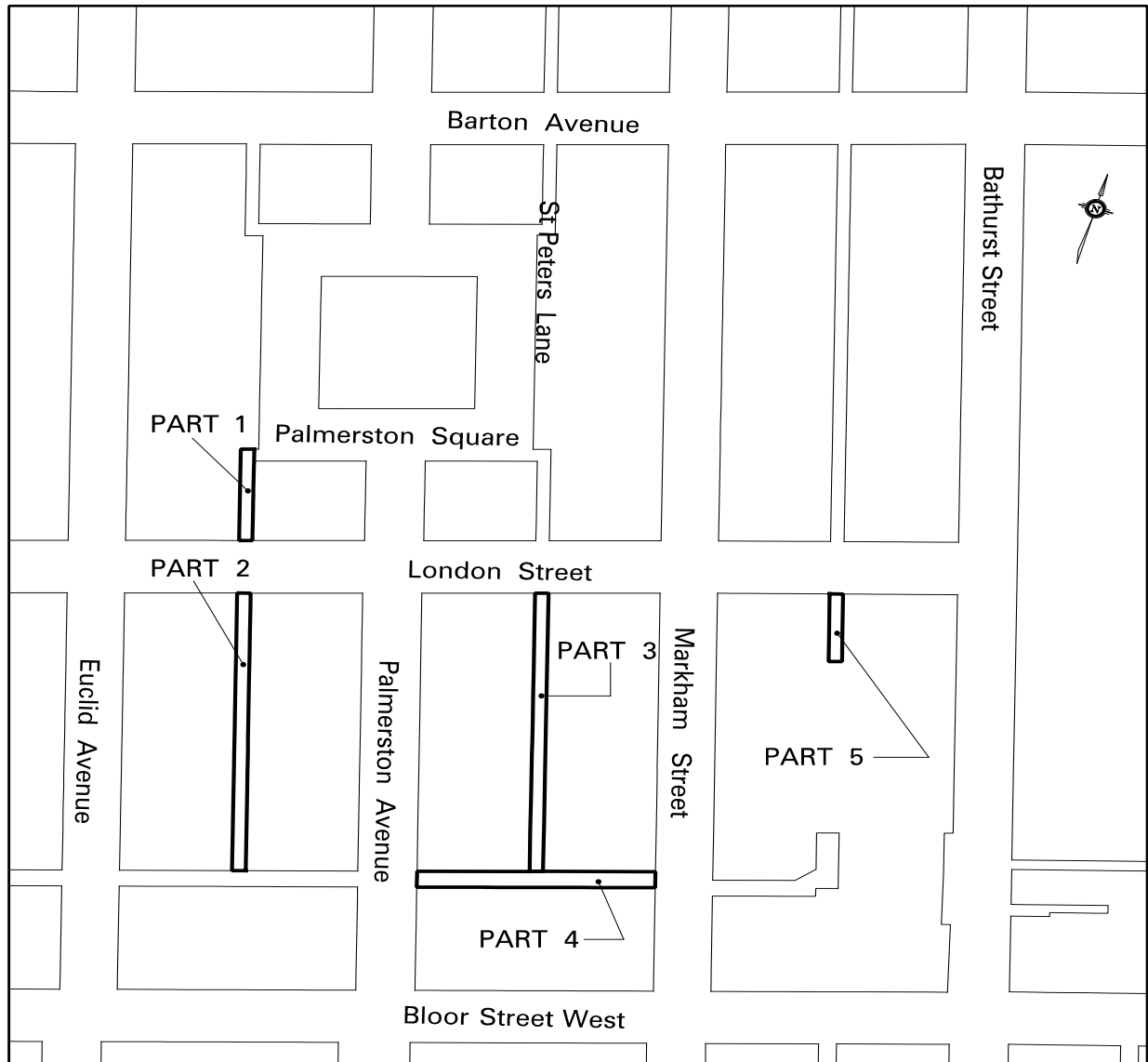
