BY-LAW 391-2018

To authorize the naming of a public lane located west of Palmerston Avenue, extending southerly from Vermont Avenue to Yarmouth Gardens as Mourning Cloak Lane.

Whereas pursuant to Section 27-152E(5) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, Toronto and East York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law naming the public lane;

and shown as PART 4 on the sketch attached to this By-law is named Mourning Cloak Lane.

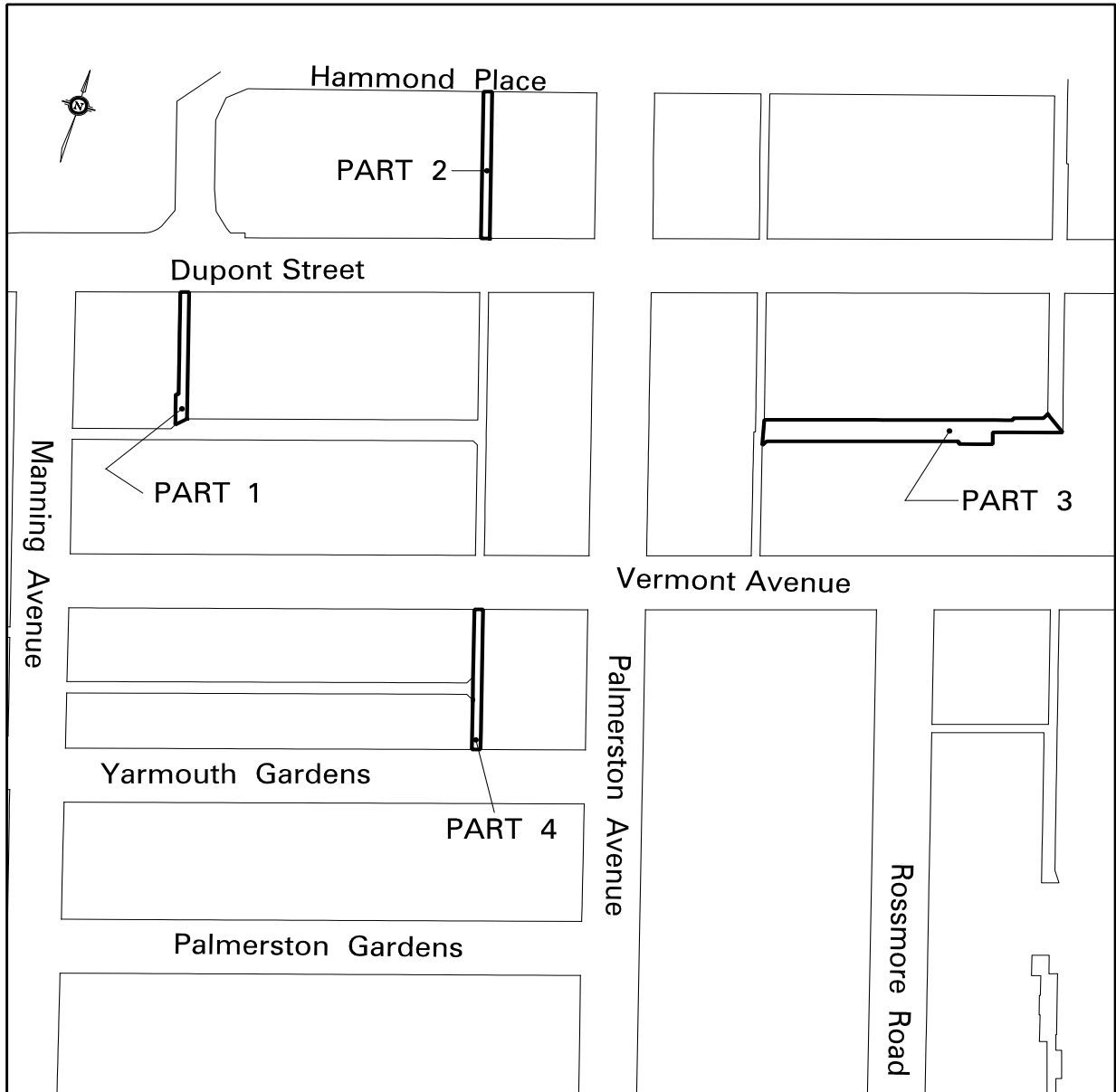
