**BY-LAW 392-2018**

**To authorize the naming of a public lane located west of Markham Street, extending southerly from London Street as Police War Horse Lane.**

and shown as PART 3 on the sketch attached to this By-law is named Police War Horse Lane.

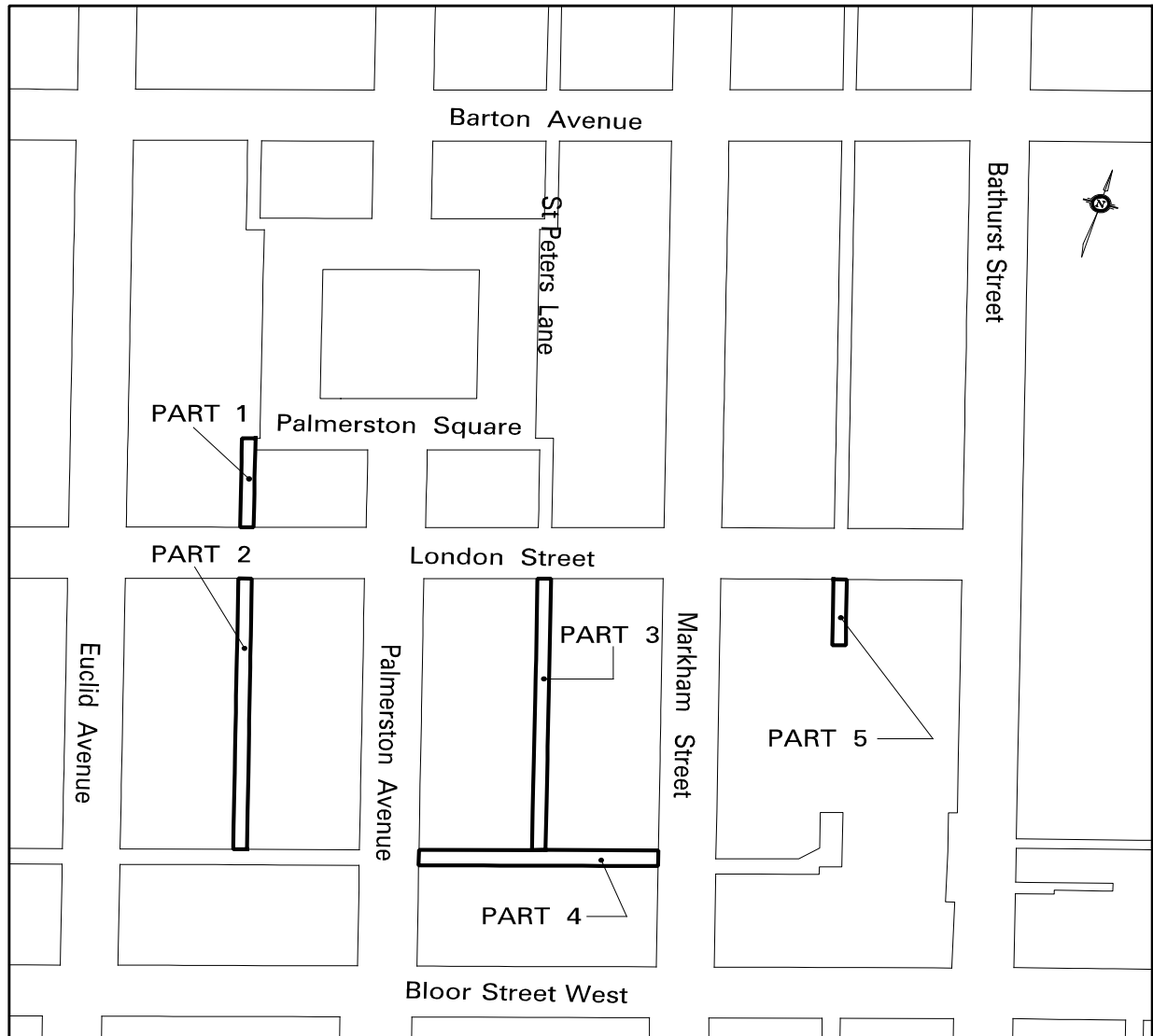
