BY-LAW 672-2018

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Quebec Avenue.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Quebec Avenue	East	A point 41 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 20 metres further north	6:00 p.m. of one day to 7:30 a.m. of the next following day; 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.; Anytime Sat. and Sun.

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Quebec Avenue	East	A point 41 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 20 metres further north	6:00 p.m. of one day to 7:00 a.m. of the next following day Mon. to Fri.; Anytime Sat. and Sun.

- C. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Quebec Avenue	East	A point 41 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 20 metres further north	7:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	10 mins.

- D. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Quebec Avenue	East	A point 41 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 20 metres further north	7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	10 mins.
