**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 729-2018**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting the naming of the first east-west laneway south of St. Clair Avenue West, between Glen Eden Crescent and Glenfield Crescent, as Jack Christie Lane.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Lane	Both	Glen Eden Crescent and Squires Avenue, first south of St. Clair Avenue East	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Jack Christie Lane	Both	Glen Eden Crescent and Glenfield Crescent	Anytime
Lane first south of St. Clair Avenue West	Both	Glenfield Crescent and Squires Avenue	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
