**BY-LAW 841-2018**

**To authorize the alteration of King George's Drive, between Keele Street and Trethewey Drive, by the installation of speed humps.**

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on King George's Drive, between Keele Street and Trethewey Drive, was conducted, and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Etobicoke York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on King George's Drive;

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of King George's Drive, between Keele Street and Trethewey Drive, by the installation of two speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing EY17-024 dated April 2018 attached to this By-law, is authorized.

Enacted and passed on July 4, 2018.
