BY-LAW 877-2018

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Cherokee Boulevard.

The North York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Cherokee Boulevard	South	Shawnee Circle (northwest intersection) and a point 215 metres east	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	10 mins.

B. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Cherokee Boulevard (east-west leg)	South	Shawnee Circle (northwest intersection) and Apache Trail	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	10 mins.
Cherokee Boulevard (east-west leg)	South	A point 78 metres east of Apache Trail and Cherokee Boulevard (north-south leg)	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.	10 mins.

C. By deleting from Schedule XXXVII (School Bus Loading Zones) in § 950-1336, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Cherokee Boulevard	South	A point opposite the east limit of Apache Trail and a point 38 metres east thereof	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

D. By inserting in Schedule XXXVII (School Bus Loading Zones) in § 950-1336, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Cherokee Boulevard	South	Apache Trail and a point 78 metres east	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
