BY-LAW 883-2018

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Mallory Crescent, Moore Avenue and Southvale Drive.

The North York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXVI (Through Highways) in § 950-1325 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

The west side of Mallory Crescent (west intersection) and the west side of Mallory Crescent (east intersection)

C. By deleting from Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Column 2
Stop Street or Highway)

Moore Avenue and Mallory Crescent

Moore Avenue (eastbound)

Southvale Drive and Astor Avenue

Southvale Drive (westbound)

D. By inserting in Schedule XXVII (Compulsory Stops) in § 950-1326, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection)	(In Column 2 Stop Street or Highway)
Mallory Crescent and Moore Avenue/Southvale Drive (east intersection)	Mallory Crescent
Moore Avenue and Southvale Drive/Mallory Crescent (east intersection)	Moore Avenue
Southvale Drive and Moore Avenue/Mallory Crescent	Southvale Drive
