CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 919-2018

To authorize the naming of a public lane south of Queen Street East, extending between Scarborough Beach Boulevard and Glen Manor Drive as Bloomsday Way.

Whereas pursuant to Section 27-152E(5) of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, Toronto and East York Community Council has the authority to pass a by-law naming the public lane;

and shown as PART 4 on the sketch attached to this By-law is named "Bloomsday Way".

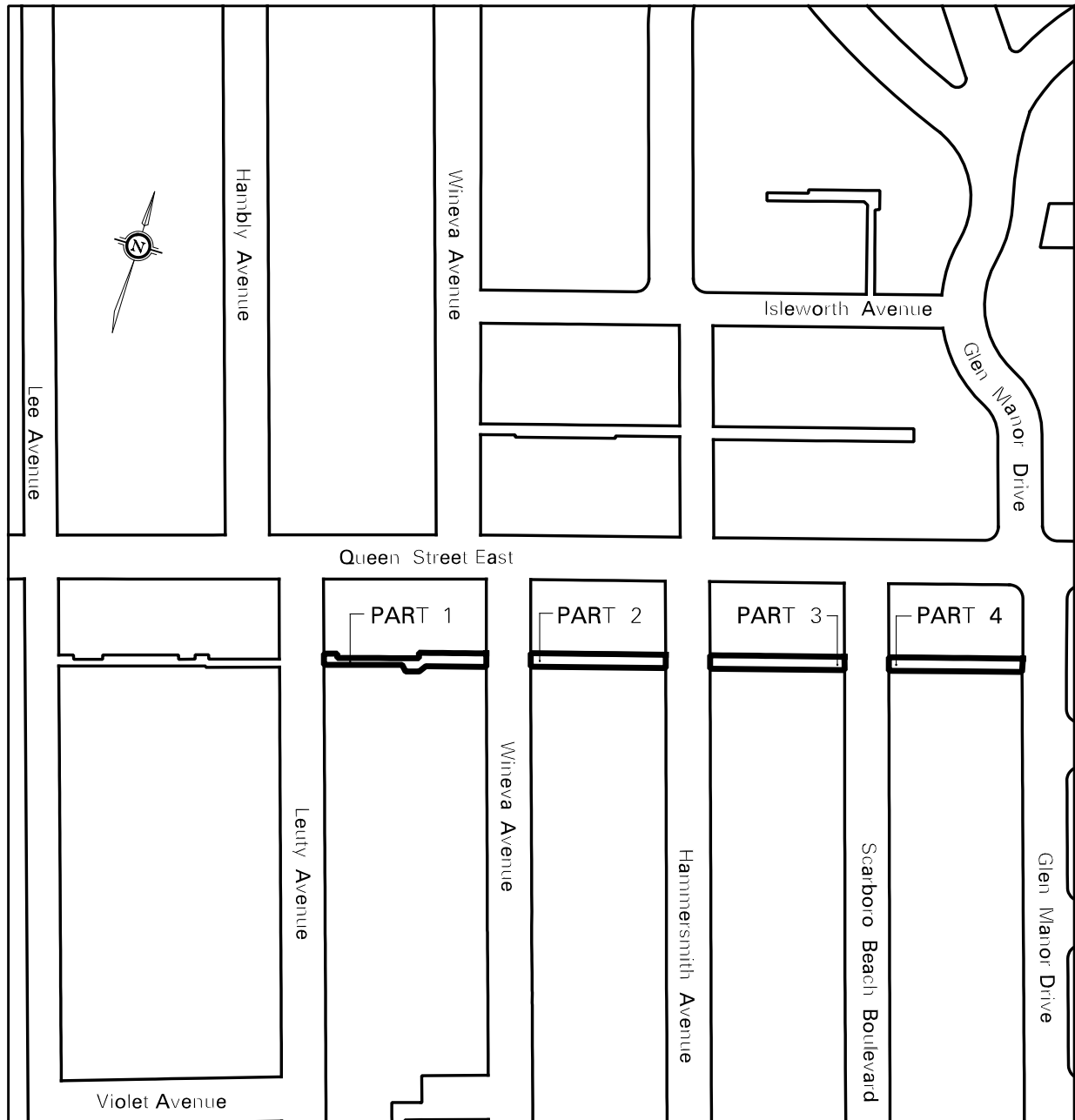
