**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 1167-2018**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Torbarrie Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By deleting from Schedule IV (Former City of North York Winter Maintenance Parking Prohibited) in § 950-1303, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Torbarrie Road	East	Sergio Marchi Street and a point 120 metres north	8:00 p.m. of one day to 8:00 a.m. of the next following day	12 hours
