**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 1237-2018**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Sentinel Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Sentinel Road	West	Sheppard Avenue West and a point 38 metres north	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313 the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Sentinel Road	East	A point 149 metres south of Sharpecroft Boulevard and a point 20 metres north of Sharpecroft Boulevard	Anytime
Sentinel Road	East	Sheppard Avenue West and a point 19 metres north of Steamdale Court	Anytime
Sentinel Road	West	A point 38 metres north of Sheppard Avenue West and a point 36 metres north of Brookwell Drive	Anytime
Sentinel Road	West	Fredrick Mowat Lane and a point 144 metres north	Anytime

- C. By deleting from Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Direction)
Sheppard Avenue west and Sentinel Road	Sheppard Avenue West and a point 30.5 metres north	Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound right-turning (buses excepted)

- D. By inserting in Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
Sentinel Road	Sheppard Avenue West and a point 38 metres north	Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound right-turning
