CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1252-2018

To authorize the entering into of an agreement for the provision of a municipal housing facility at 180 Sheridan Avenue.

Whereas section 252 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006 provides that the City may exempt from the payment of development charges land or a portion of it on which municipal capital facilities are, or will be, located and an agreement for municipal housing facilities may allow for the lease, operation or maintenance of the facilities; and

Whereas paragraph 18 of section 2 of Ontario Regulation 598/06 prescribes municipal facilities used for affordable housing as eligible municipal capital facilities; and

Whereas subsection 7(1) of Ontario Regulation 598/06 requires that in respect of municipal facilities used for housing, that all the housing units fall within the definition of "affordable housing" as that term is defined in the Municipal Facility Housing By-law 124-2016; and

Whereas The Bill McMurray Residence Inc. has agreed to provide affordable housing at the property currently known as 180 Sheridan Avenue, Toronto; and

Whereas the portions of the Premises identified in Schedule A are to be primarily used for affordable housing (the "Eligible Premises"); and

Whereas Council wishes to enter into agreements with The Bill McMurray Residence Inc. for the provision of municipal capital facilities for use as affordable housing at the Eligible Premises;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The City of Toronto is authorized to enter into an agreement under section 252 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006 with The Bill McMurray Residence Inc. for the provision of affordable housing at the Eligible Premises, in accordance with Ontario Regulation 598/06 (the "Agreement").
2. The Bill McMurray Residence Inc. shall be exempt from the payment of development charges in respect of the Eligible Premises imposed by the City under the Development Charges Act, 1997, S.O. 1997, c.27, while this by-law is in force.
