BY-LAW 82-2019

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Hillside Avenue, Mulock Avenue and Nickle Street.

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Mulock Avenue	East	A point 51.9 metres south of Hirons Street and a point 5.5 metres further south	From the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive
Mulock Avenue	West	A point 57.6 metres south of Hirons Street and a point 5.5 metres further south	From Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive and from the 16th day to the last day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive

B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Hillside Avenue	North	A point 24 metres west of Queens Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Mulock Avenue	East	A point 85.3 metres north of Hirons Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	From the 1 st day to the 15 th day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive

Mulock Avenue	West	A point 85.2 metres north of Hirons Street and a point 5.5 metres further north,	From Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive and from the 16 th day to the last of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive,
Nickle Street	South	A point 36.5 metres east of Sedan Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime
