BY-LAW 147-2019

To authorize the alteration of Hillsdale Avenue West, between Yonge Street and Duplex Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Hillsdale Avenue West, between Yonge Street and Duplex Avenue, was conducted, and as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Hillsdale Avenue West;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

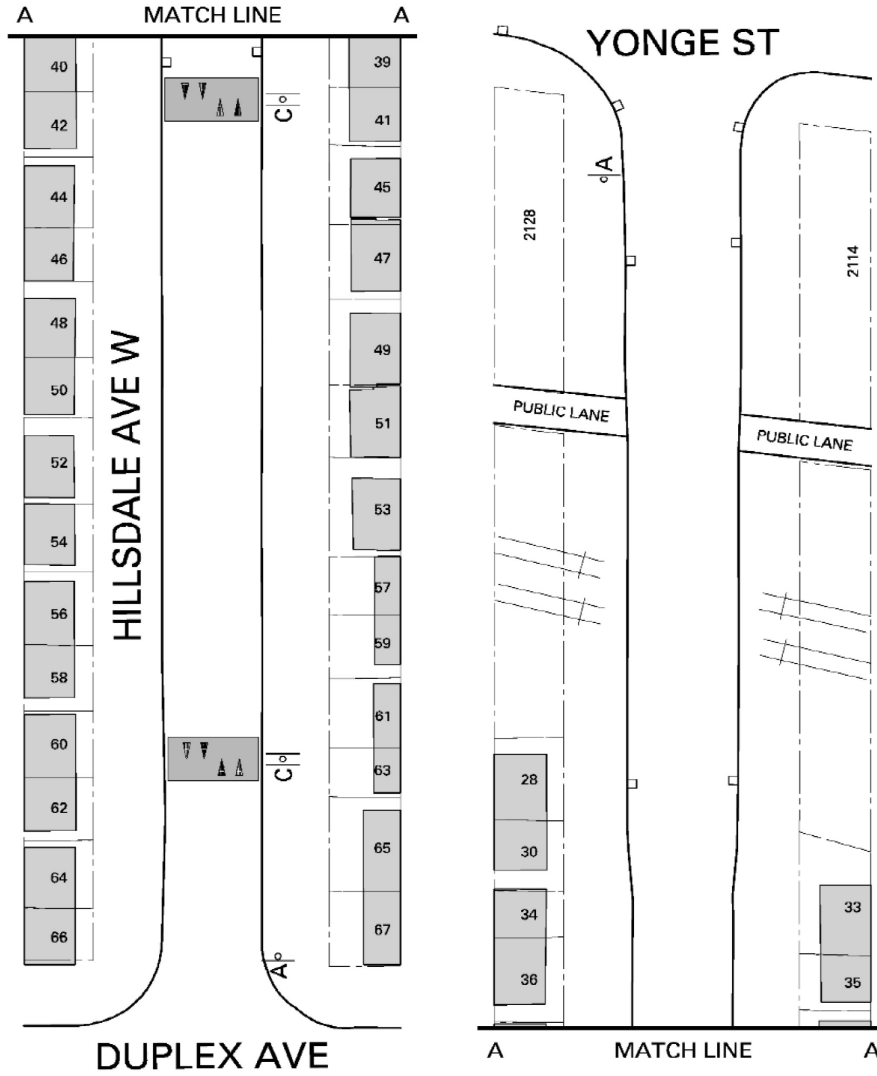
1. The alteration of Hillsdale Avenue West, between Yonge Street and Duplex Avenue, by the installation of two speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing 421G-2764, dated November 2017 attached to this By-law, is authorized.

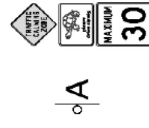
