BY-LAW 150-2019

To authorize the alteration of Claxton Boulevard, between Kenwood Avenue and Connaught Circle, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Claxton Boulevard, between Kenwood Avenue and Connaught Circle was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Claxton Boulevard;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Claxton Boulevard, between Kenwood Avenue and Connaught Circle, by the installation of four speed humps as shown on Drawing 421G-2795 dated December 2017 attached to this By-law, is authorized.
